
Southern Cardamom REDD+ Project

INVESTMENT PRIORITIES



The Southern Cardamom REDD+ Project will use carbon revenues to strengthen and expand a number of priority interventions that are strategically placed inside and outside the project area.

Wildlife Release Station

Animals rehabilitated at the Phnom Tamao Wildlife Rescue Center (near Phnom Penh) are released back into the wild. Ranger stations were strategically placed near the release station to prevent recapture of wildlife.



Ranger Stations

The Project currently supports 9 ranger stations and 3 sub-stations, composed of 148 Ministry of Environment Police, the Royal Gendarmerie Khmer and Wildlife Alliance civilian rangers.



Community Agriculture

Developing new agricultural equipment & operations in Sovanna Baitong village. Introducing new frog and chicken raising concepts to the communities of Chay Louk village.



Community Anti-Poaching Units

Made up of members of the Chi Phat community and Ministry of Environment officials who apprehend poachers in possession of wildlife, dismantle hunting camps, and remove illegal logging vehicles and equipment.



Infrastructure Development

Improvement of roads and development of bridges and water drainage culverts to link villages, improving local connectivity. High tech water wells under construction across the beneficiary villages.



Community-based Ecotourism

Providing training to community ecotourism service providers in hospitality, cooking and guiding skills. Currently implemented at two locations within the project zone: Chi Phat and Chhay Areng.
